Double Twisted Easel Tutorial

Supplies:

- Paper Trimmer with Scoring Blade
- 8" x 8" Cardstock for base
- Two 4" x 4" pieces of Cardstock or Designer Paper
- Two 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" pieces of Neutral Cardstock
- Stampin' Dimensionals/Pop-Dots
- Adhesive
- Multiple Die Cuts, Chip Board or other Dimensional Accents.



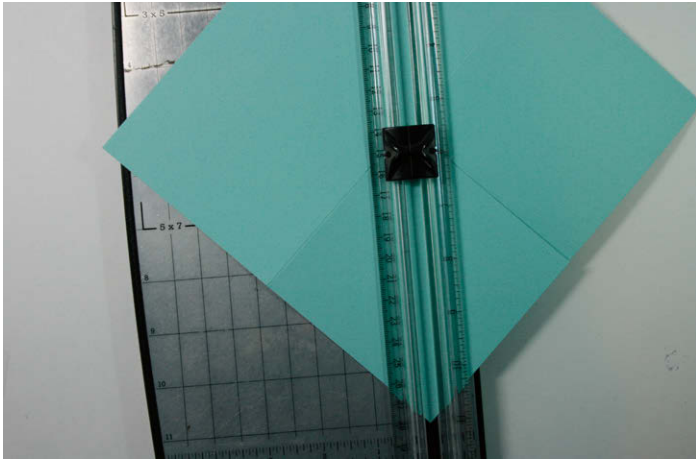
Step One:

Score the 8" x 8" cardstock in half.



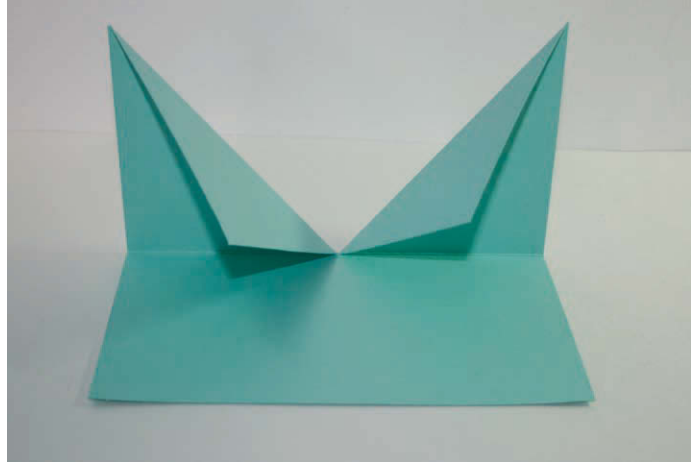
Step Two:

Rotate the cardstock and position the cutting blade at the mid point (4"). Cut down to the score line, but not beyond it.



Step Three:

Score two quarter panels diagonally. The score should start at the corner of the cut you just made and end at the opposite corner. Do this on two sides, with the score lines making a "V".



Step Four:

Fold and crease both scored lines.



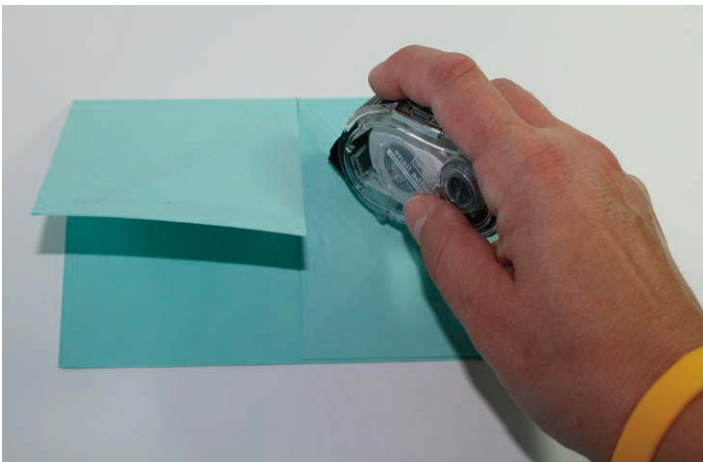
Step Five:

Stamp and color images on neutral cardstock.



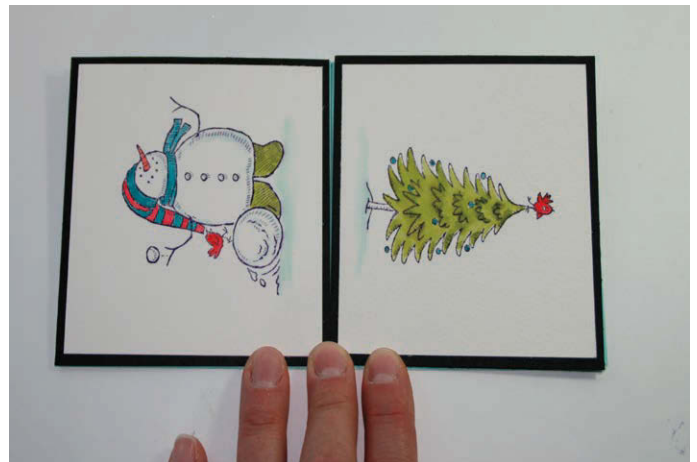
Step Six:

Mat images on 4x4 cardstock.



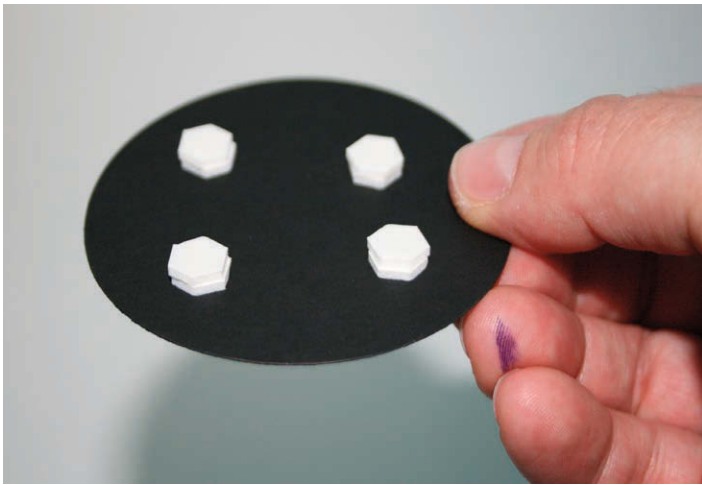
Step Seven:

Apply adhesive only to the bottom triangle in each quarter.



Step Eight:

Adhere images to cardbase making sure they are orientated end to end.



Step Nine:

Create an easel stopper using die cuts, chipboard or other dimensional accents. Apply a double layer of Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of your stopper.

Adhere stopper in the middle of the two easel panels and finish as desired.
